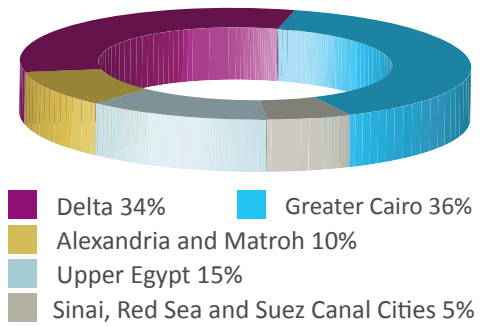

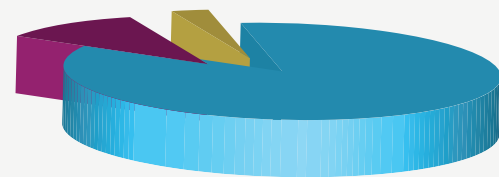

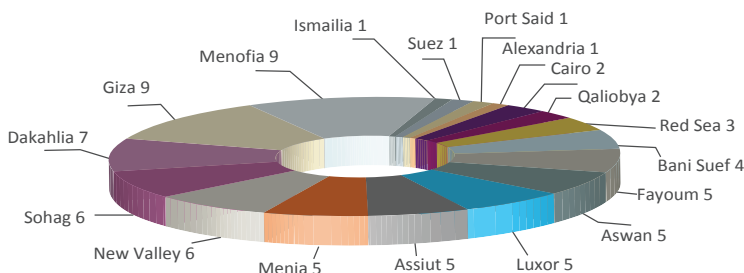


IT Clubs
