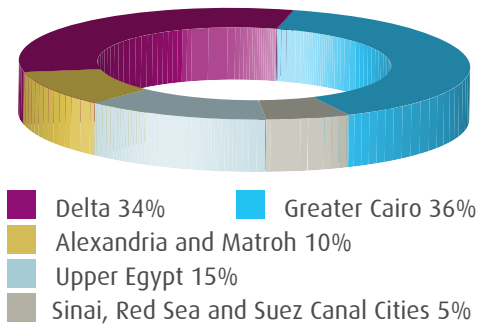

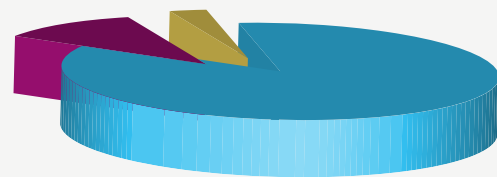

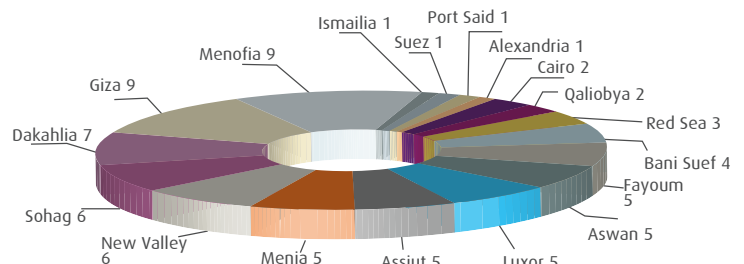


IT Clubs
